

# Paper Flowers

## What you need:

- 4–6 pieces of any color tissue paper cut into squares, approximately 8" x 8"
- 1 pipe cleaner
- scissors

## What you do:

1. Stack the pieces of tissue paper with edges aligned, alternating colors.
2. Fold the stack as a fan (back and forth) in one-inch folds until you have a 1" x 8" piece.
3. Use scissors to round out both edges of your “fan.”
4. Squeeze the tissue “fan” in the middle and twist a pipe cleaner tightly around it for the stem.
5. Carefully fan out the tissue, then separate the petals and shape the flower and stem by pinching in the middle to bring the petals together.
